

The Hunter and the Hunted



This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child is learning in Year 3 this half term.

Maths

As mathematicians, the children will be developing their knowledge of multiplication and division. They will begin to multiply and divide a two-digit number by one-digit numbers. The children will then move onto learning about units of measurement in length and begin to explore perimeter.

Humanities

As geographers, children will be taking part in local studies of birds and locating these on a map of the British Isles. We will learn about migration of birds and will think about a bird's eye view.

Science

As scientists, children will learn about food chains and about the hierarchy of animals. Children will also study skeletons and how they support the body for both animals and humans. We will look at how a muscle works within the body.

English

As writers, the children will continue to develop their writing to entertain skills and will be exploring and writing a historical narrative with a focus on adding historical detail to characters, setting and events. Our Guided Reading sessions will support our learning about predators food chains.

Art/DT

As artists, children will be exploring sketching and observational art. Children will be learning about different features and patterns as well as using collage and a range of materials.

French

As linguists, the children will study the unit 'les fruits' and will learn the names of fruits and vegetables as well as being introduced to the simple opinions 'I like' and 'I do not like'.

PSHE / RE

For PSHE, the children will focus on manners, making new friends and managing feelings. In RE, children will be learning about philosophy and how people make moral decisions.

PE

As sports people, children will develop their skills in gymnastics and stretching/flexibility.

Computing

In Computing, the children will be revisiting online safety as well as using the internet for research. They will use desktop publishing software and consider careful choices of font size, colour and type to edit and improve premade documents.

Music

As musicians, the children will be learning skeleton dancing and songs about the human body. Percussion instruments will be used to improvise and create word rhythms. They will also be enhancing their French language learning through songs.
