Art and DT

PE

- We will be following the AMAVEN program for PE
- Learning fundamental skills and techniques needed for games

English

- Practising our sounds, tricky words, blending and segmenting in daily phonics sessions
- Continuing to embed CFFS – capital letters, finger spaces, full stops, does it make sense?
- Handwriting
- We will be following The Power of Reading scheme with our Mystery Book and exploring the text and characters in detail.

Maths

- Counting in multiples of 2, 5, and 10.
- Odd and even numbers
- Measuring length, height and weight.
- Place value
- Marvellous Maths sessions to recap and revisit addition, subtraction, place value and shape.

Science

- Investigating materials and their properties from the UFO crash landing.
- Balloon Rocket experiments
- Earth, Space and the solar system.
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ICT

- Learning ICT independently through continuous provision as well as a variety of educational games on the Interactive White Board
- Using drawing apps and tools to create an alien picture on the iPads.

Music

- using our voices to create sounds and music
- weekly singing assemblies
- learning how to play music with different percussion instruments
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Humanities

- In RE we are following the Norfolk RE program.
- Open the book assemblies, weekly.
