Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 3 trip to Whitlingham - Wednesday 5th June

On Wednesday 5th June Kestrels class will be going on a trip to Whitlingham Country Park as we continue our 'Flow' topic. Whilst we are there, we will be doing some exciting activities with Broads Authority staff including lake dipping, geocaching and a mini-beast safari.

We travel to Whitlingham by coach, leaving school just after 9:00am and returning in time for the end of the normal school day.

The children will be outside most of the day so please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather conditions and has a waterproof coat, sturdy shoes and wellies (in a carrier bag) to change into. They will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks (no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets please).

Activities and trips such as these are a very valuable part of the curriculum and a great way to bring a topic to life for the children. However, we have to ask parents for a voluntary contribution to cover the costs, as we have no alternative source of funding. Although the charge is 'voluntary', we do hope most parents will pay otherwise it may not be possible for the trip to go ahead. The Broads Authority charge is £5 per child and the transport works out at £5, so the contribution we are asking parents to make is £10.
