

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are nearly there. Well done everyone on a super year of learning. I am pleased to announce that the overall winning house for this term is Birch. They will receive a reward during next week.

A number of parents have asked about handing over thank you gifts and cards to staff. These do not need to be quarantined and can be handed over to staff at pick up. Alternatively, please feel free to send them in with your child. Thank you.

All year groups have had or are due to have a trip outside of school. I have been very impressed with the reported behaviour of the children outside of school and received this email to confirm this. "I was lucky enough to be invited to accompany YR3 on their trip to the dinosaur park on Wednesday. I wanted to drop you a little note to say how impressed I was at the behaviour of the group I was asked to look after. They were polite, respectful and kind to each other and to me."

For the last 3 days of term we have planned a number of activities including a year group Cineplex and a whole school treat. Similarly, if your Year 5 or 6 child wishes to cycle to school on their own we would prefer them to have completed the Bikeability course in school.
