



Conquering Romans



This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half term. Wherever possible, learning will be linked to our focus topic – Conquering Romans.

We will read *Escape from Pompei* by Christina Balit in our English lessons. We will be using this as inspiration to write a historical narrative.

As **scientists**, we will be working scientifically to find out about the digestive system, teeth and food chains.

As **historians**, we will be studying **the Romans** – the impact of the Roman Empire on Britain and Queen Boudicca.

As **mathematicians**, we will be developing our multiplication and division skills. We will also complete a topic on length and perimeter.

As **readers**, we will focus on retrieval and inference skills when comprehending texts.

As **musicians**, we will be listening to music from the past and using this as inspiration to compose our own.

As **artists**, we will be using printing techniques to create our own mosaics.

As **geographers**, we will look at compass points and the extent of the Roman Empire.

In **computing** lessons, we will learn about data and information, including data logging.
Online Safety – our topic will be online reputation.

In **PE** lessons, we will complete units on gymnastics and handball.

In **RE**, our big question will be:
What do we mean by truth?

In **French**, we will be learning: As tu un animal?

In **Learning for Life** lessons, we will explore families and healthy relationships.

As **designers**, we will be evaluating, designing and making healthy salads.
