



Blue Abyss!



This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half term. Wherever possible learning will be linked to our focus topic.

In Year 4 as readers and writers, we will be reading *The Bluest of Blues*, building reading stamina and focusing on retrieval questions.

We will focus on using subordinate clauses, apostrophes, determiners, the present perfect tense and verb inflections. We will explore and write biographies.

As scientists we will find out about living things and their habitats. We will apply this learning in other areas of the curriculum, including learning about the botanist Anna Atkins.

As geographers we will be investigating coastal erosion and its links to climate change. We will link this to our science work on how microplastics enter the environment.

As mathematicians we will be developing our understanding of fractions and decimals, including equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions, and fractions that are more than 1 whole one. We will also measure length and perimeter.

As musicians we will look at the topics of Ancient Worlds and Singing in Spanish.

In computing we will explore programming using Scratch.

As designers, we will create our own submarines using our knowledge of electricity.

In PE lessons, we will focus of gymnastics and outdoor and adventurous activities this half term.

As artists we will create our own cyanotype prints based on plants.

As linguists we will continue learning about As tu un animal?

In learning for life we will be learning about eating healthily and health and fitness.

In online safety we will explore online bullying and how we can manage this.
