



Hola Mexico



This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half term. Learning will be linked to our focus topic: Hola Mexico, as well as our Science topic: light.

As **writers** we will be developing our narrative writing skills by using dialogue to convey character and advance the action. We will also be developing our persuasive writing skills.
As **readers** we will be looking at a variety of texts, using it to work out the meaning of unknown vocabulary.

As **scientists** we will be understanding how light travels and bends, and how we see colour.

As **mathematicians** we will looking at fractions, revisiting previously learnt skills before progressing on to using them with the four operations.

In **RE** we will exploring the question: 'How do Christians bring hope at Christmas?'

As **designers**, we will be creating our own Mexican dish based on our understanding of the culture and cuisine.

As **geographers** we will be studying the human and physical geography of Mexico. We will be making comparison between life there and in the UK.

As **computer scientists** we will be developing our understanding of e-safety.

In **PE** lessons we will be improving our fitness and understanding the importance of keeping healthy.

As **historians**, we will explore the Mayan civilisations: who they were; games they played and where chocolate comes from.

In **learning for life** we will continue to explore our PATHs curriculum and RSHE curriculum.

In **French** we will complete our work on *En Famille*
