



This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half term. Wherever possible learning will be linked to our focus topic Road Trip USA!



In Year 4 as readers and writers, we will be reading *The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane* and building reading stamina.

We will focus on using apostrophes, determiners, the present perfect tense and verb inflections. We will explore and write narrative pieces and descriptive poetry.

As scientists we will find out about electrical circuits, conductors and insulators. We will apply this learning in other areas of the curriculum.

In RE, we will be looking at the questions *Why is there so much diversity of belief within Christianity? What does sacrifice mean?*

As mathematicians we will be developing our understanding of decimals, money, time and shape, as well as making sure we are all confident with multiplying and dividing.

As musicians we will explore American music and linking dance to our topic on the U.S.A.

As artists we will be creating dream catchers.

As historians we will explore the history of Native Americans.

In computing lessons we will be learning how to manipulate images using photo editing software.

In PE lessons we will be focus on playing dodgeball and athletics

In French we will be learning the vocabulary related to *Au Cafe*

As designers, we will be creating our own electronic games.

As geographers we will be using World and U.S. maps and examining physical and human geography, including comparing 2 countries.

In Online Safety we will be looking at how we manage online information

In Learning for Life we will look at our Health and prevention of illness, how our body will change and sun safety.
