Dear Parent/Carer,

This has been a long but very productive term and I would like to thank you all for your continued support.

The children and staff are ready for the Easter break following all the excitement and hard work of the last few weeks.

Thank you to the PTA who funded an egg hunt today for all the children. The year 6 helped me run this and were amazing.

Please be aware that the school gates open at 8.40 and registers close just after 9.00. Some children are arriving on site just after 8.30am. Please be aware that your child is not supervised at these times. A few children are regularly late into school which causes more work for the office and disrupts learning for other children. We do completely understand that sometimes lateness cannot be helped but please try to avoid it as much as possible. There are also a small number of children for whom this is a reasonable adjustment that you have discussed with us as a school.

Further to last week's newsletter, we are having a working party on Tuesday 5th April between 9am – 12pm. If you are able to spare the time and help, that

will be greatly appreciated. Please come to the main entrance, and we will make our way round to the area. During the morning we will be:
