



## Traders & Raiders



This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half term. Wherever possible learning will be linked to our focus topic - Traders & Raiders.

In Year 4 as **writers** and **readers** we will be reading **Beowulf**, learning new vocabulary, and engaging with a story set in the Anglo-Saxon era. We will write our own stories.  
We will continue to revise and practise all year 4 grammar and punctuation

As **scientists** we will be working scientifically to find out about living things and their habitats

In **RE** we will be looking at the questions  
*Why is there so much diversity of belief within Christianity? What does sacrifice mean?*

As **mathematicians** we will be developing our understanding of statistics, properties of Shape, as well as making sure we are all confident with adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing.

As **musicians** we will be learning about traditional music and performing.

As **artists** we will be working with clay to recreate Anglo Saxon pots and artefacts.

As **geographers** we will be completing a local field study.

In **computing** lessons we will be reviewing the use of word processing software.

In **Learning for Life** we will be learning about Drugs, alcohol and tobacco  
We will also learn some basic first aid.

In **French**, we will be Au Cafe, learning the language of food and drinks and how to order in France.

As **designers**, we will be making mechanical models using cams.

As **historians** we will be studying the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings

In **Online Safety** we will be looking at how our online habits impact health, wellbeing and lifestyle. We will also look at privacy, security, copyright and ownership.

In **PE** lessons we will focusing on Cricket and Rounders
