



This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half term.

Wherever possible learning will be linked to our focus topic Road Trip USA!



In Year 4 as <u>readers and writers</u>, we will be engaging in reading and writing through the classic text: "The Iron Man" by Ted Hughs. We will focus on using imagination write persuasively, use of interesting verbs and other vocabulary. We will also work further on punctuation for direct speech and use of subordinate and main clauses in sentence structure.

As <u>scientists</u> we will be exploring the science of sound. We will explore volume and pitch and learn about sound waves.

As <u>mathematicians</u> we will be developing our understanding of addition and subtraction, multiplication, and division We will also work on how to calculate area.

We will also use knowledge of capacity to help us measure liquids.

As <u>artists</u> we will explore and create our own dream catchers.

As <u>designers</u> we will explore levers and their uses in history as well has using them in design and technology.

As <u>historians</u> we will explore the history of Native Americans and how they were impacted by European discovery.

In <u>computing</u> lessons, we will will be creating media and investigating photo editing.

In <u>PE</u> lessons we will continue with basketball and tag rugby, as well as working on fitness.

In <u>French</u> we will be learning the vocabulary of the classroom.

In <u>RE</u>, we will try to answer the question: What do we mean by truth? We will look at the Sikh, Hindu and Christian religious beliefs. As <u>geographers</u> we will be using World and U.S. maps and examining physical and human geography, including comparing 2 countries.

In | Online Safety we will learn about on-line relationships and how to maintain safety.

In <u>Learning for Life</u> we will find out about respectful relationships, including different types of relationships.
