Consultation on Inspiration Trust admission arrangements for September 2025 entry

As you will be aware from previous communications, The Inspiration Trust is currently asking people to comment on their proposed admission arrangements. The long-term prospects for Mulbarton Primary pupils to be able to attend Hethersett Academy may be affected by these proposals. We would urge parents or any affected parties to respond to the consultations and voice their opinions.
