There are changing facilities, we ask that all Dads accompany their child in the male changing rooms and Mums accompany their child in the female changing room.

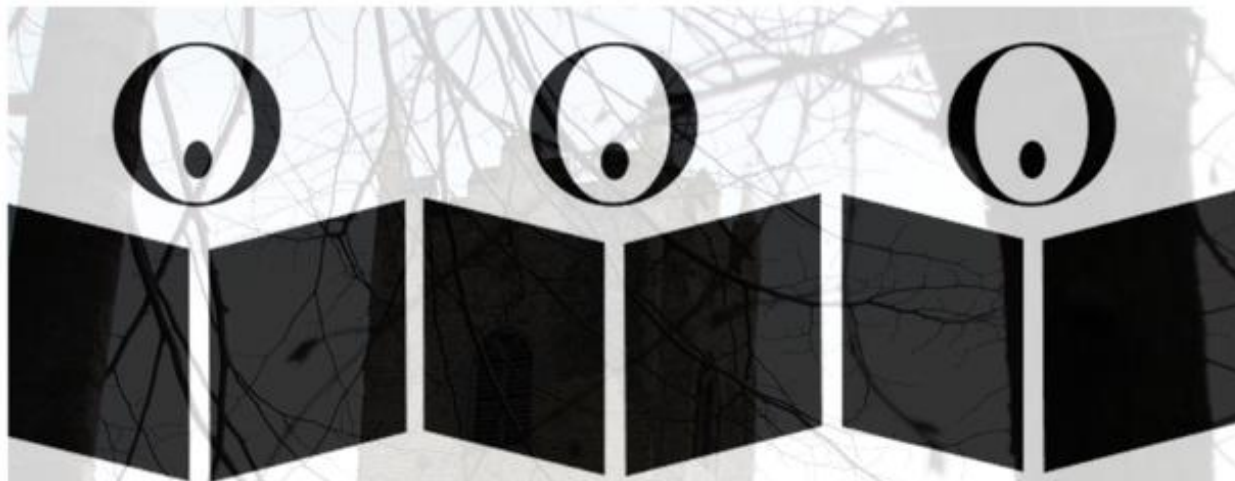
PAYMENT METHODS
